

Levels of Care

LEVELS OF CARE MAY INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:

Basic Assisted Living- Provides residents a safe place and the freedom to enjoy their own interests without the burden of cooking, cleaning, and home maintenance. Residents enjoy three delicious meals a day, social activities, and community transportation. We provide at least three safety checks per day at meal times. Nurses are on site 24 hours a day should an emergency arise.

Level 1 - Includes our Basic Assisted Living as well as medication management to help manage your prescriptions in a safe, appropriate and effective manner.

Level 2 - Includes Level 1 in addition to:

- 24-hour caregiver service supervised by licensed nurses
- Supervision and cueing with Activities of Daily Living
- Weekly shower assistance

Level 3 - Includes Level 2, in addition to:

- One-person minimal transfer assistance
- Minimal assistance with Activities of Daily Living
- Regular physical assistance with incontinence
- Mobility (escorts to activities and meals) as needed

Level 4 - Includes Level 3, in addition to:

- One-person moderate transfer assistance
- Moderate assistance with Activities of Daily Living including eating
- Specialized diet modifications

Level 5 - Includes Level 4, in addition to:

- Assistance with Hoyer lift and two-person transfers
- Significant assistance with Activities of Daily Living including eating
- Requiring Hospice/End of Life services
- Total feeding assistance
